

## Subject: Use of jetties and berths in canal dock B3 as a waiting berth for inland vessels.

The use of jetties and berths in canal dock B3 as waiting berth is only possible after allocation by the Central Tank Farm. Quay Q2 (709) and Quay Q803 (761) can only be used as a berth for sampling, after allocation by the Central Tank Farm.

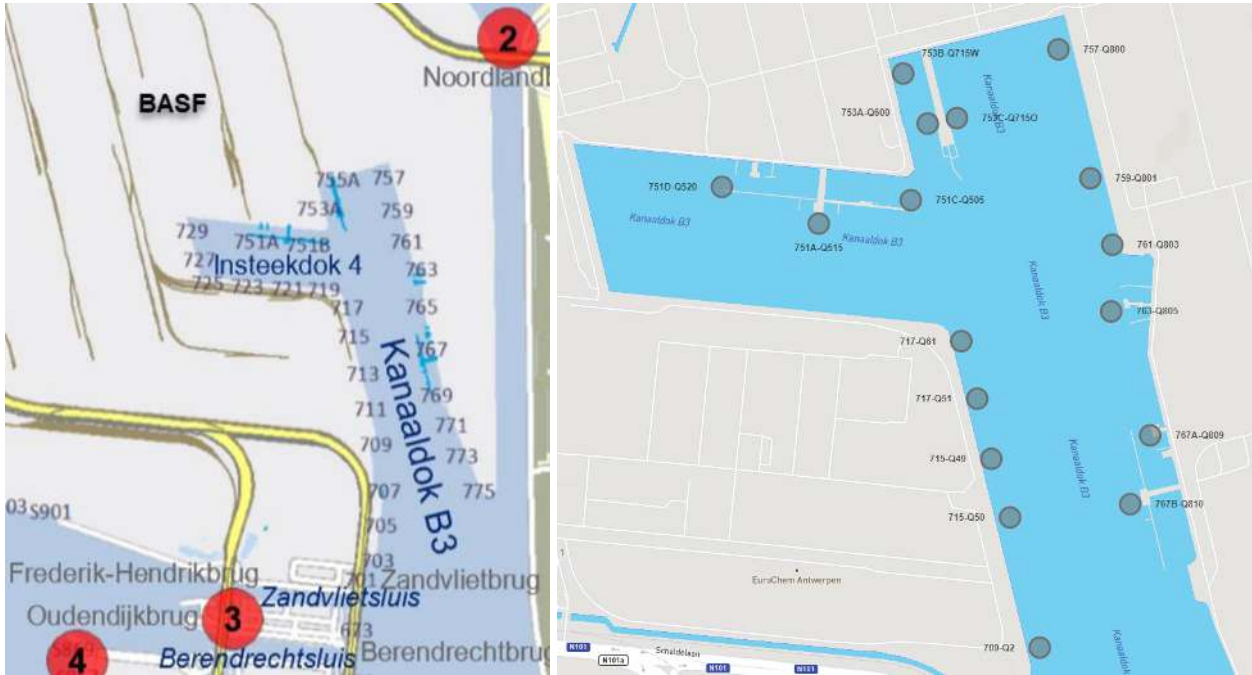
